In view of current COVID-19 pandemic which has most severely affected the normal functioning of schools in the country, however, the school is pursuing to provide extension of affiliation so as to svoid any difficulty for the purpose of admission /registration/ obtaining instrumental of various safety certificates from appropriate state authorities.

Prevelote, the competent authority of the Board after due consideration has accorded approval for extension of Affiliation based on assistant submitted by school in online application for a further period of 5 years subject to fulfilment of following conditions:

- the school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issues thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt, from time to time.
- The School is required to apply on online for further extension of attiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per
- The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned as mentioned in certificate as per appendix III issued by District Education Officer (DEC) receivalent officer.
- The school should ensure the strong governance and management of its activities in way of comprehensive and quantifiable planning in way of comprehensive and quantifiable planning in way of comprehensive and other co-corricular areas.
- The school should go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Lows and keep a copy there of for reference purpose and also advised to visit CBSE websites i.e. http://cbseacademic.nic.in/ a http://cbse.nic.in/ for updates. The School is expected to see all circulars on these CBSE websites regularly.
- The school will strictly adhere to all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting and Transportation, etc. Further, school will provide adequate facilities for potable drinking water and clean healthy and hygienic toilets with washing facilities for boys and girls separately in proportion to the number of students. The school will ensure that Fire, Building, health and sanitation and safe drinking water certificates are renewed from time to time, as per norms.
- Admission to the achool is to be restricted as per relevant rules of Examination Bye-laws and rule 2.4.5, 2.6.5, 7.1, 7.2, 8.4.2, 8.4.10 is other relevant rules of Affiliation bye laws.
- The school is required to follow rule No. 2.4,7 and 2.4.8 of Affiliation Byz Laws regimeing books and Quality of Education.
- The number of sections may be restricted as per the Appendix V of the Affiliation B, e-Lews of the Board. For increase in number of sections, the School shall apply online to the Board as per rule 15.7 of Affiliation B to Linus.
- The school shall be scient responsible for any legat consequences arising out of the use of school name/loge/society/trust or any other loentity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. The school shall also be liable to bear all legal charges inclined by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances.
- The school must strive to promote conservation of environment on their campus through rain water harvesting, segregation of waste at source, recycling of organic waste, proper disposal of waste including electronic waste, use of energy saving and energy efficient electrical equipment, greening of compus, use of solar energy, education and awareness amongst children on environment
- The school shall submit their information through Online Affiliated School Information System (OASIS) as per details given in circular no. affiliation-05/2018 dated 24-04-2018. Link for OASIS is available on Board's website: www.cbse.nic.in
- The optimum Section teacher ratio of 1:1,5 as well as student teacher ratio of 30.1 is to be maintained to teach various subjects and school shall appoint qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.
- Every affiliated school shall sponsor regularly its benafide and eligible students in Boards Class XI and Class XII examinations from the year mentioned while granting affiliation/up-gradation regularly vithout preak or inform with reasons thereof in writing well in time about the non-sponsoring of the candidates.
- Running of casching institutions in the school premises in the pretex; of providing couching to the students for various examinations is not permitted by the Board. Street across would be taken on defaulters.
- The Manger and the Principal of the school shall be jointly responsible for the authenticity of the online/offline documents/ information/data submitted by the School to the Board.
- Again from rules to be adhered to by the school as ment and above for thrawing specific attention of the school authorities, the school authorities are required to acquaint themselves with all the rules contained in Affiliation & Examination Bye-laws and circulars/guidelines/notification issued by the Board from time to time. Any laxity in following rules/instructions of the Board will lead to action against school as per clause 12 of Affiliation Bye-laws-2018.
- The genuineness of information / documents / data submitted shall be of school and in case, if found otherwise the school shall invite 18. action as per affiliation Bye laws-2018
- The school shall be responsible for submission of any pending compliance, reply of show case /legal notice/ complaint and for submission of date/information sought by the Board. The extension of S years shall be from the date of cessation of previous validity of extension of affiliation
- The school is required to remit pending fee, if any
- The extension of affiliation is being granted as one time measure. However, the cases where the Show Cause Notice was communicated or grievance / legal cases are pending against the achoot, the Board unit take appropriate decision in this matter
